

- 1 8 oz Bar Cream Cheese (Room Temp)
- 1 16 oz Container Cool Whip
- 2 Tbsp Margarine, melted
- 1 4 oz Jar Caramel Topping

- 1 14 oz Can Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 Graham Cracker Pie Crust
- 1/2 Cup Chopped Pecans

Cooking Instructions: Combine cream cheese with sweetened condensed milk in medium mixing bowl. Add cool whip and continue mixing. Pour half of mixture into each pie crust. In small sauce pan place margarine and pecans and stir over low heat until margarine is completely melted. Place on top of pies. Cover and freeze for 8 hours or until firm. Before serving, drizzle each slice with caramel topping.
